Our yearly planning is flexible in EYFS and although we plan themes for the year ahead, with the nature of Early Years we find that the needs, interests and abilities of the children do not always fit with the planned topics. With this in mind we adapt our planning to the needs, abilities and interests of the children. Our topic headings are broad allowing us to adapt and allow for individual needs and interests to be explored.
